## FROM THE PRINCIPAL . . .

### God sends us to Repent & Forgive

There are perhaps no harder words for us to say than “I’m sorry”. I experience it with my own kids. We see it with the students that we serve at Milwaukee Lutheran. We witness it amongst our colleagues. I, personally, struggle with it as well. Sometimes it is our own blindness to sin that convinces us that we are not wrong. Other times our pride stands in the way of the humility needed for a right heart.

Scripture calls us to examine our hearts. We are called to repentance for those things that we have done in thoughts, our words, and our actions. We are called to repent of those wrongs we have done and when we have failed to do the right things.

*“The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent and believe the Gospel.”  
(Mark 1:15)*

While it is often difficult for us to recognize our own shortcomings, we are all pretty adept at seeing those shortcomings in others. Because our Heavenly Father forgives us, we are called to forgive others.

*For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.  
(Matthew 6:14-15)*

After the command to make disciples and baptize, this may be one of the most critical roles we fill in the Christian community. As we interact with each other we are prone to cause harm and be harmed by one another. Yet, Christ calls us specifically to take on the roles of repentant sinner and gracious forgiver. May we have the honesty to recognize our own sin and the boldness to forgive as Christ has forgiven each of us.

## **School Records Broken!**

On Saturday, April 23 the Red Knight track and field team traveled to Wisconsin Lutheran High School to compete in the Carleton Sitz Invite. On this day, not one, but two long standing school records were broken. Senior Ke’Vontae Wall-Burdine broke the school record in the 100-meter dash, set by Mike Funk (‘92) in 1992. Ke’Vontae established the new school record with a time of 10.81 seconds, which now qualifies him for the best 100-meter time in the state of Wisconsin for the 2022 season. Ke’Vontae added to his special day by breaking the school record in the 400-meter dash, set by Rollan Parish in 1987. Ke’Vontae broke this record with a time of 49.52 seconds. Milwaukee Lutheran High School would like to congratulate you on this amazing achievement.
