

ACADEMIC UPDATE & TESTING INFORMATION

Weighted Grades

In an effort to ensure academic excellence, Milwaukee Lutheran High School will be converting to a weighted grade scale.

Grades will now be weighted on a 5.0 scale to represent more challenging AP or college level coursework completed, rather than a traditional 4.0 scale. For



example, a regular track course will be weighted at 4 points in a student's GPA, while an AP or college level course will be weighted at 5 points.

All grades will be retroactively weighted to accurately reflect the AP course work completed for current students.



Fall Testing Day will take place on October 23rd beginning promptly at 8:00am. While being on time is important everyday, it is particularly important on testing dates.

Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors will be taking the Pre-ACT, which serves as an indicator for the success on the ACT. The ACT informs **scholarship**

opportunities and entrance to colleges and universities. Encourage your student to perform to the best of their ability, in order that we can accurately ensure we meet their future academic goals.

Seniors will be virtual on 10/23.

WINTER SPORTS REGISTRATION

Winter registration will open in mid-October. If your son or daughter does not have a physical on record here at MLHS, please contact your family doctor to get an appointment before the season begins. If you are not sure if your student athlete has an updated physical on file, please contact the athletic office. The physical documentation may either be brought into the Athletic Office in person or emailed to Todd Albers at talbers@milwaukeelutheran.org or Jordan Cloyd at toloyd@milwaukeelutheran.org. Students cannot try out for a team if they do not have a physical on record, and they can not be registered for winter athletics. Each season/sport played requires the family of each student athlete to pay the \$60 athletic fee.




First Stage Musical Theatre Workshop

If you plan to use a professional



photographer, you need to allow them at least 2 weeks lead-time, if not more. <u>No phone selfies or screenshots will be accepted.</u>

You can participate in this free service* just by sending a text message of "Y" or "Yes" to our school's short code number, 67587.

You can also opt out of these messages at any time by simply replying to one of our messages with "Stop".

Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes: SMS stands for Short Message Service and is commonly referred to as a "text message". Most cell phones support this type of text messaging. Our notification provider, SchoolMessenger, uses a true SMS protocol developed by the telecommunications industry specifically for mass text messaging, referred to as "short code" texting. This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers.

If you've ever sent a text vote for a TV show to a number like 46999, you have used short code texting.
