## POINTS OF EMPHASIS FOR THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR

Like all schools, MLHS has a core of school rules which are upheld to assure for an orderly year. In addition to these core rules which can be found in the school handbook, MLHS is placing a special emphasis on the following:

**Demonstration of Buying into the Learning Process:** MLHS does not expect each of our students to receive As on every test/assignment. However, MLHS does expect each student to do his/her God-given best. By doing one's best, a student sets himself/herself up for having numerous opportunities upon graduation from high school.

**Timeliness:** Timeliness to school is expected. Students should be on campus in enough time to be in their first period classroom by 8:00 am – the start of the school day. Once in class, students should plan on remaining in the room for the whole class period. Timeliness to each class following first period is also required. Students who are frequently late to school, late to class, or consistently in the hallway during class will face significant disciplinary action, up to and including suspension and/or expulsion.

**Dress Code/Uniforms:** MLHS has adopted a school uniform for this school year. The cooperation shown by both students and parents in implementing this school policy has been outstanding. Thank you for your help!

**Chapel:** Our gymnasium turns into holy ground during our chapel times – normally on Monday and Thursday mornings. While outstanding behavior is the norm for our students, this expectation rises to yet another level when we are worshipping our Lord and Savior.

**Phones:** Student phones are not to be seen and/or used during school hours. Phones will be confiscated from students should this rule not be followed. Parents needing to contact their student should do so through contacting the school office.

**Propping Outside Doors Open/Opening Doors For Others:** Outside doors are not to be propped open. Outside doors are not to be opened for others. All visitors must come to the main entrance and be buzzed-in. Students who prop outside doors open/open doors for visitors will be suspended/expelled. We are simply this serious about our school safety.

Fall registration for Football, Volleyball, and Cheer are closed. If your students would like to participate in Cross Country, Boys Soccer, or Girls Swim, there are still opportunities to register. Please make sure your student has an athletic physical completed before registering. Athletes can not participate without an athletic physical. Please visit our website and click on the Athletic Registration page at the top of the screen to sign up for Cross **Country, Boys Soccer, or Girls** Swim.

Even though we just started school and our fall seasons, it is never too early to get prepared for the winter season. If your student plans on playing Boys or Girls Basketball, Wrestling, or Boys Swim, please make sure that you contact the athletic office to ensure you have the proper paperwork and documents completed. An athletic physical will need to be completed before the first day of practice. These physicals are good for two years and are mandatory by state law to be on file before practice begins. Girls Basketball will begin on November 6, Boys Basketball will begin on November 13, Wrestling will begin on November 13, and Boys Swim will begin on November 13.
